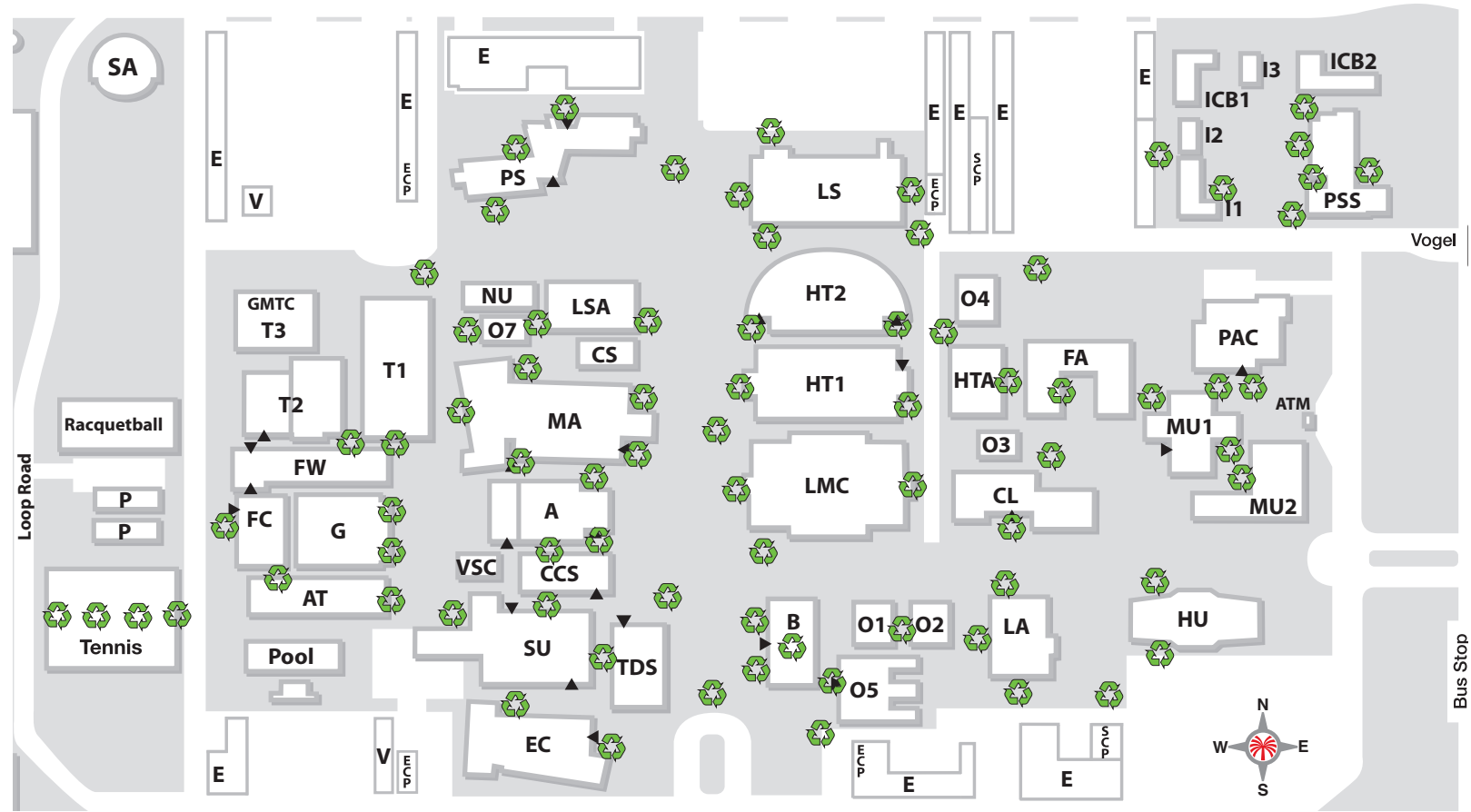




RECYCLE PROGRAM

What Is Recyclable?

Paper - Newspaper and mixed paper, incl. advertising inserts, magazines, junk mail, catalogs, brown paper bags and telephone directories.

Cans - Aluminum and steel/tin, for example beverage cans, clean foil and foil baking pans, soup or vegetable cans.

Plastic - Plastic Containers 1-7, such as water bottles, soda bottles, milk jugs, detergent and fabric softener bottles, yogurt containers, margarine tubs, and food containers. No plastic bags, styrofoam, or bubble wrap.

Boxes - Cardboard and chipboard, empty of all packing materials and broken down; for example, corrugated boxes, cereal, cracker and cake mix boxes (without inserts).

IMPORTANT - Please **DO NOT** put any garbage in Recycle Bins!
Any garbage placed in recycle bins contaminates the entire bin.
